



#### **US dollars per capita**

The approximate health spending in the Latin American and Caribbean region in 2023, converted to US dollars, was around \$334.20 per capita (population in Latin America and the Caribbean is 670,000,000 habitants) Keep in mind that this is an average, and individual country figures may vary.





#### **Grow in basic equipment in Latin** America: 2022

- EKG machines 16%
- Patient monitors 17%
- X-ray machines 13.5%
- Anesthesia machines 9%
- Ventilators 36.5%
- Ultrasound machines 40%
- Infusion pumps 41%

### **Specialized equipement growth in** 2022:

- Tomography scanners 41%
- C-arms 9%
- Mamography scanners 62%
- Hemodialysis machines 60%
- MRI machines 57%
- Angiography machines 61%
- Gamma cameras 84%
- Radiotherapy equipments 7%





#### 25% of all hospitals in the world, are **located in Latin America**

- Developed economies 28%
- China 23%
- Latin America 22%
- Rest of the world 27%

#### **Medical devices**

- 95% of medical devices sold in Latin America are imported.
- In Latin America, the revenue of the medical technology market was estimated at more than 44 billion U.S. dollars in 2023
